

# **Spider**

#### Clue

#### Information

And of course, we human beings are also enemies to spiders as sometimes people that don't like them stand on them.



## **Butterfly**

### Clue

With my long tongue I feed on nectar!

## Information

There are 56 species of butterfly in the UK.

They are important pollinators.

Butterflies taste with their feet and live on an all-liquid diet.



## **Beetle**

### Clue

I have strong armour on my back.

I come in lots of colours but often I am coloured black and I like to live in piles of rotting wood.

## Information

Although they have two pairs of wings, beetles only use their hind wings for flying.



## Ant

### Clue

### Information

### Clue

A gardener's friend, I'm not fussy about what I eat.

I live in the soil and help things to rot and recycle back into soil.

### Information

Earthworms can live for 3-4 years, on average but have been found to be as old as 15 years!



# Ladybird

### Clue

Brightly coloured to warn other animals and birds to leave me alone, I hibernate through the winter and only wake up in the spring when the temperature begins to warm.

I am a gardener's friend.

## Information

A ladybird is a type of beetle.
